The Lake Placid Olympic Center hosts the third annual Adirondack Winter Invitational presented by the Golden Arrow on Friday, Nov. 28 and Saturday, Nov. 29, showcasing four teams from three of the premier Division I collegiate men's hockey conferences in the nation.

From Hockey East, UMass Lowell. From the Great Northwest Athletic Conference, Alaska Fairbanks. From ECAC Hockey, St. Lawrence and Clarkson.

Join us for two action-packed days featuring four games (two each)—It all goes down in the legendary Herb Brooks Arena—the same ice where the Miracle on Ice stunned the world in 1980. Points mean everything, and only one team will skate away with the Adirondack Winter Invitational title.

TOURNAMENT HISTORY

Landing right in the thick of early conference play, the Adirondack Winter Invitational shakes things up with high-stakes, non-conference showdowns on neutral ice—perfect prep for the battles ahead in the second half of the season.

The tournament's history already packs drama: In 2023, Arizona State claimed the first-ever title, outlasting Cornell in a shootout thriller. Clarkson grabbed third, edging UMass Amherst 5–4 in an overtime nail-biter. One year later, in 2024, UMass Lowell muscled past Providence to hoist the trophy.

NANOOKS SET TO SKATE IN LAKE PLACID AGAINST SLU FOR FIRST TIME

- This matchup is the first Alaska/St. Lawrence matchup in program history.
- Alaska is competing in their first-ever Adirondack Winter Invitational. This is the third-annual Adirondack Winter Invitational and will also feature Clarkson, St. Lawrence, and UMass-Lowell.
- The Nanooks are coming off of a two-week bye after facing Simon Fraser in an exhibition game on Nov. 8 and a five-game road trip from Oct. 24-Nov. 4.
- This is the second in-season tournament for the Nanooks this year. Their first road trip of the year was at the Icebreaker Tournament in Tempe, Ariz. They placed second after falling to ASU in the championship.

COLD HARD FACTS

- **A CENTURY IN THE MAKING:** The Nanooks are in the midst of their 100th year as a program. After forming in 1925-26, the Nanooks have played at the club, NCAA Division II and Division I levels. This is the Nanooks second stint as a program competing in the Independent Division I ranks. They have been an independent team since 2021-22 when the now-era CCHA was born.
- **IN THE TRENCHES: 500 YEARS OF ALASKA HOCKEY:** UAF University Relations released a 45-minute documentary on the history of Alaska Nanooks hockey and the history of hockey in Alaska. - **FIRST TIMES THE CHAMP:** This matchup between Alaska and St. Lawrence is the first ever, the Nanooks have not faced anyone else this season for the first time in program history.
- **THROWBACKS:** The Nanooks have five new throwback uniforms that represent the 1930's, 1950's, 1980's, 1990's and 2000's.
