SCENIC CLOUDSPLITTER GONDOLA

Take a gondola ride from the base to the summit of Little Whiteface in 15 minutes. Relax, have a picnic and enjoy the awe-inspiring views of the Adirondack Mountains and beyond.

VETERANS' MEMORIAL HIGHWAY

5021 State Route 86, Wilmington, NY 12997

Drive (or bike) up this highway that rises over 2,300 feet in five miles, with plenty of scenic stops along the way. An elevator or 15-minute hike will take you to the summit of New York's fifth highest peak.

NATURE HIKES

An expert naturalist will lead you on a two-mile intermediate loop that begins at the base, and proceeds along the West Branch of the Ausable River and returns to via the waterfall-filled Stag Brook Trail.

DISC GOLF

Follow a marked course around the lower sections of some favorite Whiteface ski trails, tossing Frisbee-like discs from basket to basket.

LAKE PLACID OLYMPIC MUSEUM

Home to one of the world's largest collections of Winter Olympic memorabilia, the museum features interactive displays, 30 visualizations, experiential learning exhibits, and engaging displays.

PUBLIC SKATING

Ice skating is part of the Olympic legacy in Lake Placid and a fun indoor activity at the Olympic Center on our historic arenas year round.

INLINE SKATING

Bring your friends or family and enjoy one of the most stunning views in the Adirondacks as you skate around the James C. Sheffield Speed Skating Oval. Themed nights with music will be on the schedule. The outdoor oval offers inline skating and skate rentals.

CURLING

This fun ice activity does not require skates and is an easy-going sport for groups of all sizes. A brief lesson introducing newcomers to curling begins the session before play. Brooms, stones and safety equipment are provided by the arena.

STICK N' PUCK

This activity provides individuals the opportunity to enhance their hockey skills in a non-contact/non-competitive environment, and is limited to 30 skaters per 90 minute session.

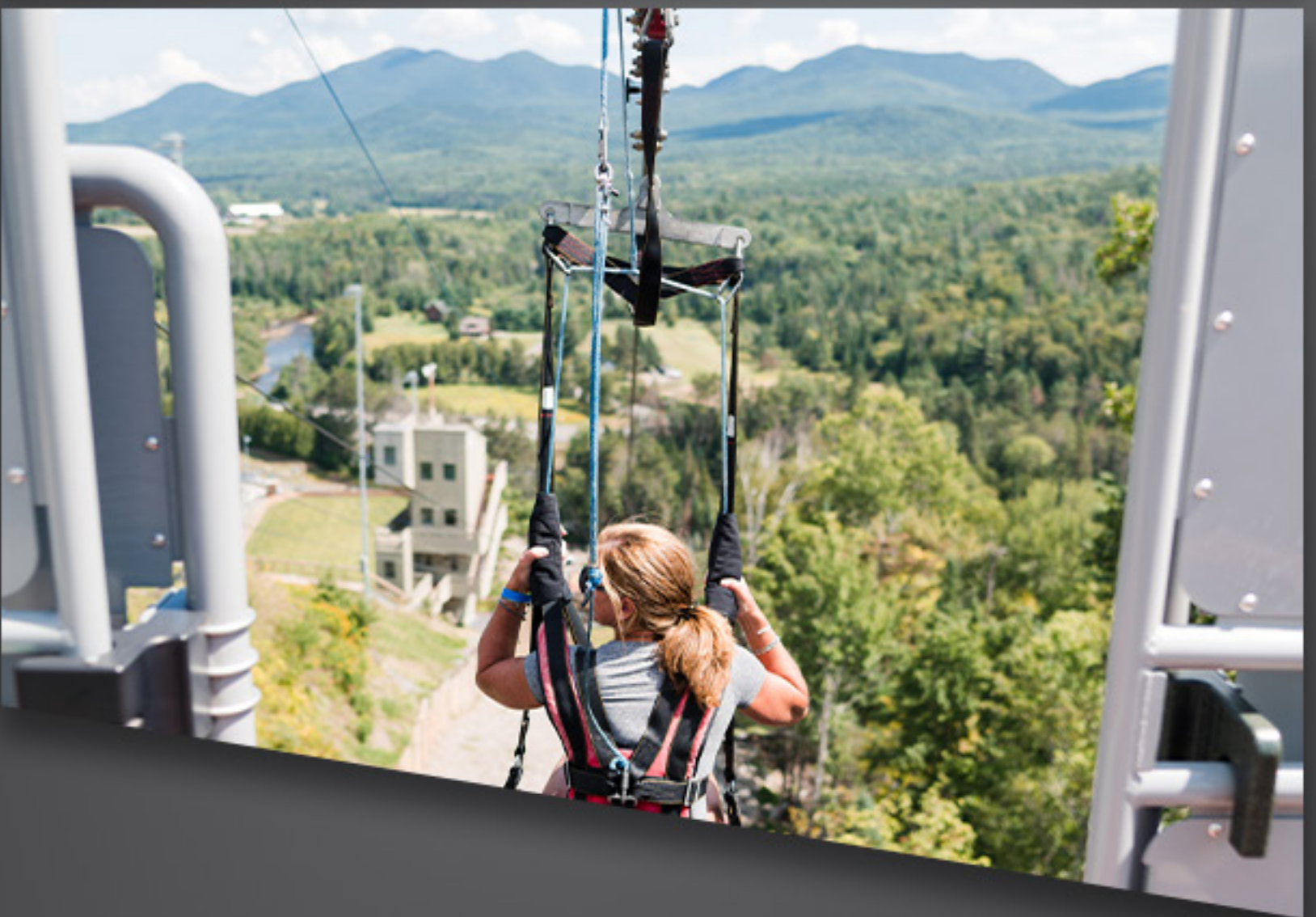

SKYRIDE

Enjoy a comfortable ride in an 8-person Gondola, followed by a glass-enclosed elevator ride to the top of the HS 128 meter ski jump to the Sky Deck, which boasts panoramic views of Lake Placid and the surrounding Adirondack Mountains. You will get up close and may even see a ski jumper training.

SKY FLYER ZIPLINE

Experience the rush of ski jumping on the Sky Flyer zipline, which follows the HS 100 meter ski jump, reaching speeds up to 30 miles per hour. You'll feel the exhilaration of an Olympic ski jumper as you soar above the ground.

ATHLETE TRAINING

The Olympic Jumping Complex is dedicated to showcasing jumping competitions and providing athletes with training facilities that develop our next generation of Olympians. We have athletes on-site training several times a week from mid-June through mid-September.

LEGACY TOUR
