2020/21 Cross Country Season Pass Terms & Conditions

NYS Olympic Regional Development Authority (ORDA)

ORDA manages and operates Mt. Van Hoevenberg and the Nordic Center at the North Creek Ski Bowl (hereinafter "ORDA Cross Country Ski Venues").

RFID Cards, SKI3 Cards, or plastic identification passes (hereinafter "Season Pass Cards") provide access to ORDA Cross Country Ski Venues and/or ORDA ski lifts via a gate system and/or scanners. This is only the name of the card itself. Access to the ORDA Cross Country Ski Venues and/or ORDA ski lifts is determined by the products purchased by the customer and loaded onto the Season Pass Card (trail passes, season passes, lift tickets, etc.).

The venue from which you purchase your season pass (either in person, by mail, or online) will be considered your "Home Venue" and referred to as such throughout the terms of this agreement. For reporting lost or stolen Season Pass Cards, transactional questions, or general questions governing your pass, please communicate directly with your Home Venue.

Terms and Conditions of Purchase:

- All purchases are final:** Future promotions are independent of this offering. **NO refunds** for any reason, including but not limited to: sickness, injuries, relocation, health problems, weather conditions, man-made or natural disasters.
- ORDA Cross Country Ski Venues reserve the right to change opening and closing dates, operating hours, number of days in the week open, restrict access to any open terrain at any time based on weather, snow, crowds, special events or any other condition or reason. ORDA Cross Country Ski Venues also reserve the right to determine the terrain in operation or area available for use at any given time based on snow, weather or other condition or reasons. A minimum number of operating days is not guaranteed.
- Season passes are non-transferable and are for the pass holder's exclusive use only. Any fraudulent use will result in the season pass being revoked.
- Age at time of purchase will determine eligibility for all passes except the 70+ pass; customers turning age 70 during the 2020 calendar year may purchase in advance of their birthday and remain eligible for the 70+ pass. Proof of age required.
- For full-time college students, ORDA uses a national database of college enrollment status to verify enrollment status. If your school is not represented in the database, you will be contacted via phone or e-mail to request verification of your status as a full-time student.
- You may choose to keep your existing photo (from the 2019/20 season) or upload a new season pass photo when purchasing online, or you may update your pass photo in person at your Home Venue. Your Home Venue, at its discretion, can request that a new photo be taken.
- A Season Pass Card will be issued or reloaded for each season pass purchased. This Season Pass Card serves as your permanent trail pass for the season.
 - For RFID Cards and SKI3 Cards:** Your RFID-enabled card must be secured on your person and in a location that can be read by the gates or every trail access point occasion. It is recommended that your pass be placed somewhere between waist height and shoulder height. Do not place your RFID-enabled card in a wallet or near a cell phone; this will prevent the RFID-enabled card from being read properly.
 - For Plastic Identification Passes:** This pass must be clearly presented to the Ticket Checker/Scanners at every trail entrance.
- If your Season Pass Card is lost or stolen, you must notify your Home Venue at once. A replacement fee may be charged to process a new Season Pass Card.
- Any misuse, fraudulent use, misconduct or nuisance caused by the passholder or failure to follow New York State law may result in revocation without refund or other considerations. ORDA management reserve the right to revoke season passes depending upon the severity of the infractions.
- All pass purchasers must sign the Cross Country Season Pass Terms & Conditions digitally through the 1Risk waiver system before receipt and/or use of Season Pass. If purchasing online, a signature is required on the Cross Country Season Pass Terms & Conditions, which is presented immediately following completion of your payment. If purchaser does not have access to the internet, the Home Venue will provide access to a digital device where the purchaser can sign the Cross Country Season Pass Terms & Conditions in person at the Home Venue. Persons under age 18 must have a parent or legal guardian digitally sign the Cross Country Season Pass Terms & Conditions.
- All dates, rates, and provisions are subject to change without notice.**

Photograph and Other Likeness Consent Release

I grant to ORDA, their successors, assigns, or employees, the right to use my name and any likeness of me and/or of my minor or custodial children captured during my use of a season pass at Whiteface, Gore, Belleayre, Mt. Van Hoevenberg or the Lake Placid Olympic Sites for any purpose, including advertising, trade, exhibition, publication or promotion in print and online, commercial and non-commercial. "My likeness" includes a photograph, video recording, film or artistic rendering of me, a recording of my voice, and/or reproductions of any of these. I agree that the actual material involved, such as a photograph, negative, plate, video recording, film or audio recording, is and shall be the property of ORDA.

I understand and agree that I will not be compensated in any way for the use of my/our name or any likeness by ORDA, and I hereby waive all claims to any fees or other considerations or remuneration for use of my/our name and/or likeness regardless of their realized potential commercial value, and release ORDA, their employees, agents and assigns from all claims and liability relating to said use.

Assumption of Risk Agreement

WARNING TO SKIERS: I understand the Winter Activities involve numerous risks including, but not limited to, the risks posed by variations in terrain and snow conditions, surface and subsurface snow conditions, icy or firm snow, unmarked obstacles, thin snow cover, bare spots, bumps, moguls, stumps, forest growth and debris, erosion control devices, rocks, cliffs, steep terrain, deep snow, avalanches and other hazards. I also understand Cross Country Skiing involves risks posed by loss of balance, loss of control, falling, sliding, collisions with other skiers, and collisions with natural and man-made objects, including trees, rocks, fences, posts, lift towers, snow making equipment, snowmobiles and other over-snow vehicles; and other participants. I further agree that all of these risks and dangers are necessary to the sports of Cross Country Skiing and the Winter Activities. New York Law imposes a duty on you to become apprised of, and understand, the risks inherent in the sport of skiing, which are set forth above, so that you make an informed decision whether to participate in Cross Country Skiing notwithstanding the risks. New York law also imposes additional duties upon you, to which you must adhere, for the purpose of avoiding injury caused by any of the risks inherent in skiing.

In signing the Cross Country Season Pass Terms & Conditions of Purchase and using the season pass, I signify that I am aware of and understand the risks inherent in the sport of Cross Country Skiing and that I am accountable for my action as set forth on the WARNING TO SKIERS signs.
