TICKETS ON SALE NOW FOR MAJOR MARCH HOCKEY CHAMPIONSHIPS
*ECAC Men's Hockey Championship and NCAA DIII Men's Hockey Championship Both Coming to the
Modernized Herb Brooks 1980 Arena*

LAKE PLACID, NY - The New York State Olympic Regional Development Authority (ORDA) announced that tickets are on sale for the Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) Men's Hockey Championship and the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) DIII Men's Ice Hockey Championship, both taking place at the newly renovated Herb Brooks 1980 Arena in March. Guests can purchase in person at the ticket desk on the first floor of the Lake Placid Conference Center, by phone at (518) 523-3330, or online at www.LakePlacidLegacySites.com.

The ECAC Men's Hockey Championship semi-final games are on Friday, March 18 at 4:00 pm and 7:30 pm, and the Championship Game is Saturday, March 19 at 7:30 pm. Tickets for a single day are \$40 for adults, and \$35 for juniors and seniors. An all-tournament pass is on sale for \$60 for adults, and \$50 for juniors and seniors. The Championship will feature the best NCAA Division I teams within the ECAC.

The following weekend, the NCAA DIII Men's Ice Hockey Championship semi-final games are on Friday, March 25 at 3:00 pm and 6:30 pm, and the Championship game is at 7:00 pm. Tickets for a single day are \$22 for adults, and \$16 for juniors and seniors. An all-tournament pass is on sale for \$40 for adults, and \$28 for juniors and seniors. This Championship will feature the top four Division III teams in the United States.

Since Lake Placid last hosted the ECAC and NCAA DIII tournaments in 2019 and 2018 respectively, the Olympic Center has undergone significant modernization projects. Specifically in the 1980 Rink, upgrades include new seating, modernized media and concession areas, hospitality suites, new restrooms, a renovated concourse, LED event and broadcast-quality lighting, the ability to convert to NHL or international rink sizes, and a new air handling/dehumidification system. The 1980 Arena is networked to the Olympic Center's new industrial refrigeration plant, designed to make ice with improved reliability and efficiency.
