



SNOWSPORTS ABILITY CHART

DOWNHILL SKI

FIRST TIME

I'm a first time skier who is brand new to the sport.

SECOND TIME

I've skied once before, but I'm still learning to make turns.

NOVICE

I can turn my skis with control in both directions on Green terrain.

INTERMEDIATE

I am developing parallel turns on intermediate Blue terrain.

ADVANCED

I can make controlled parallel turns on expert Black Diamond terrain.

SNOWBOARD

FIRST TIME

I'm a first time snowboarder who is brand new to the sport.

NOVICE

I can traverse and link turns on easy Green terrain.

INTERMEDIATE

I can make controlled turns and am switch riding on Blue terrain.

ADVANCED

I ride expert Black Diamond terrain in control, including parks.

XC SKI

LEVEL 1

For beginner skiers, this is either your first or one of your first times on cross country skis.

LEVEL 2

For generally intermediate skiers. You have skied a few times but want to work on technique and skiing efficiency.

LEVEL 3

For generally experienced skiers. You may have picked up cross country skiing a few years ago and feel fairly confident but there are specific pieces of your technique you would like to work on.
